2023 APPLICATION FUTURE LEADERS OF BOSTON SCHOLARSHIP

About the University Club of Boston Scholarship Fund:

The University Club of Boston's Future Leaders of Boston Scholarship Fund was founded in 1977. Since its inception, the Scholarship Fund has awarded qualifying Boston residents who are graduating seniors scholarships to be used over four years of college. To date, well over 100 Future Leaders of Boston scholarships have been granted. These scholarships are made possible through the generosity of the University Club's membership.

The mission of the Scholarship Program is to provide financial assistance, through need-based scholarships, to Boston residents to help cover the gap funding in their college tuition each semester. Recipients of the scholarships will have distinguished themselves academically, through service to their community and will also have demonstrated their potential to be a leader.

Ambassador Program:

Upon being awarded a Future Leaders of Boston Scholarship, each recipient will be assigned to an Ambassador who is a member of the Scholarship Committee. The purpose of the Ambassador Program is to provide our scholarship recipients with a point of contact at the University Club to answer any questions related to the Scholarship Program as well as to act as a general resource for students who may have questions about their education or careers. Students are expected to remain in contact with their Ambassador at least twice during each semester and, Ambassadors should be copied on all correspondence with the University Club Administration, including the submittal of renewal applications.

Selection Criteria for Recipients:

When selecting the recipients for the Future Leaders of Boston Scholarship, the Scholarship Committee considers the following (in no particular order): Academic Achievement, Community Service, Extracurricular Activities, Financial Need and Leadership. Students should highlight their accomplishments in these areas when applying, as should the authors of the recommendation letters that are being submitted with the application. Qualifying applicants need to demonstrate one of the following:

- An EFC (Expected Family Contribution) from the FAFSA Student Aid Report that is \$10,000 or less
- A low to moderate parent Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)
- Extenuating financial circumstances

Application Process:

APPLICATION DEADLINE - Applications must be received by **8pm Monday, March 27, 2023**. Please ensure you have filled in all the pertinent information on the application and submitted all required materials, as **the Scholarship Committee will review only fully completed applications**.

SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION ELECTRONICALLY BY EMAIL - Applications can be filled-in online and are also available here: <https://www.uclub.org/scholarship-program>. Applications should be emailed to Corey Schafer, Scholarship Committee Chair, at scholarship@uclub.org or if necessary, mailed to the attention of the Scholarship Committee at the University Club of Boston (address at the bottom of this page).

APPLICATION AND INTERVIEW PROCESS: Upon review of all completed applications, the Scholarship Committee will select a round of finalists who will be invited for an interview with the members of the Scholarship Committee. After meeting with the finalists, the Scholarship Committee will select the winners and award the scholarships at an evening ceremony in early June (exact date TBD), at The University Club.

Scholarship Terms and Conditions:

Upon accepting a Future Leaders of Boston Scholarship Award, recipients must meet the following requirements every year to remain eligible to receive their scholarship:

- Maintain a minimum annual GPA of 3.0 and be enrolled each semester as a full-time student,
- Submit a scholarship renewal application every semester, together with official proof of enrollment, an updated FAFSA form and a college transcript,
- Be in touch with their assigned Ambassadors at least twice a semester, and
- By August 1 prior to each fall semester, students (except Freshman) are required to submit their transcript, Fall schedule and a written 1-2 page essay updating the Scholarship Committee on their accomplishments and challenges from the prior year.
- Provide an invoice/account bill from financial aid office to the University Club of Boston Scholarship Administration for each semester. (Copy your ambassador.)
- The scholarship will be up to amount awarded but not to exceed your gap on a per semester basis.
